Expectations of the Board As a Whole

The mission of The Wardrobe: Treasure Valley is to provide youth in foster and kinship care with empowering experiences by providing quality, customized clothing orders at no charge.

As the highest leadership body of the organization and to satisfy its fiduciary duties, the board is responsible for:

- Determining the mission and purposes of the organization.
- Selecting and evaluating the performance of the Executive Director and/or Order Management Committee.
- Strategic and organizational planning.
- Ensuring strong fiduciary oversight and financial management.
- Fundraising and resource development.
- Approving and monitoring The Wardrobe: Treasure Valley's programs and services.
- Enhancing The Wardrobe: Treasure Valley's public image.
- Assessing its own performance as the governing body of The Wardrobe: Treasure Vallev.

Expectations of individual board members

Each individual board member is expected to:

Know the organization's mission, policies, programs, and needs.

- Faithfully read and understand the organization's financial statements.
- Serve as active advocates and ambassadors for the organization and fully engage in identifying and securing the financial resources and partnerships necessary for The Wardrobe: Treasure Valley's to advance its mission.
- Leverage connections, networks, and resources to develop collective action to fully achieve The Wardrobe: Treasure Valley's mission.
- Help identify personal connections that can benefit the organization's fundraising and reputational standing, and can influence public policy.
- Prepare for, attend, and conscientiously participate in board meetings.
- Participate fully in one or more committees (as needed).

BOARD MEMBERS ARE ALSO EXPECTED TO

- Follow the organization's bylaws, policies, and board resolutions.
- Sign an annual conflict-of-interest disclosure and update it during the year if necessary, as well as disclose potential conflicts before meetings and actual conflicts during meetings.
- Maintain confidentiality about all internal matters of The Wardrobe: Treasure Valley.
